**Celebrate Black History Month,** open your hearts and minds to the essential contributions that African slaves and their descendants made in making America the great country it is today. With my career in Real Estate and my husband a home builder, I would like to introduce you to Mr. Paul Williams (1894-1980), a prominent American architect who designed



homes, and commercial buildings in Los Angeles, Arizona, Las Vegas, Palm Springs, New York, Washington D.C., and Tennessee. Williams is an example of what perseverance against all odds can do. He and his brother were orphaned when he was 4 years old. Many unproven stories of who raised the two brothers are unfounded. However, someone encouraged Paul Williams' love of art.

Paul Williams was known for his significant contributions to architecture, especially during the mid-20th century. He gained recognition for his work in designing luxurious homes for celebrities, including many in Hollywood specifically, Frank Sinatra, Lucille Ball. Notably, Williams was one of the few African American architects

practicing during the era of racial segregation in the United States.

Some of his famous projects include the iconic Theme Building at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX), the first building at the airport designed for a specific purpose rather than as a terminal. The building that I frequented in Los Angeles that he designed is Saks Fifth Ave. on Wilshire Blvd. in Beverly Hills. Williams also designed numerous elegant residences, commercial buildings, and public institutions. His architectural style ranged from traditional to modern, and he was skilled in adapting his designs to the preferences of his clients.

Throughout his career, Paul Williams faced challenges due to racial discrimination, yet he persevered and left an indelible mark on American architecture. He graduated from USC in 1919, received his architectural license in 1921, started his own practice in 1922. He became the first African American member of the American Institute of Architects (AIA) in 1923 and later served

as its national president. His legacy continues to be celebrated for his talent, innovation, and trailblazing achievements in the field of architecture.

In Case You Missed It last month, Extreme Weather with Austin Chaney. At our August meeting, we had the pleasure of hosting Austin Chaney, Chief Meteorologist for WHIO and Storm Center 7. Austin, whose passion for weather began at an early age, shared his journey to becoming a meteorologist. From giving weather forecasts on his school's morning newscast at the age of 12 to earning degrees in Atmospheric Sciences and Geography from the University of Georgia, his dedication to meteorology is truly inspiring.

During his presentation, Austin discussed the full spectrum of extreme weather phenomena that affect the Miami Valley, including tornadoes, flooding, heat waves, and snowstorms. He provided an extraordinary PowerPoint presentation that detailed the inner workings of the studio graphics, the resources used to predict weather events, and the demanding schedules that he and his team follow.

One of the most striking points from his talk was the level of stress associated with delivering bad news to the public—a challenge that is often overlooked. His insights were both informative and thought-provoking, offering us a deeper appreciation for the vital work that meteorologists do.

For those who missed it, Austin's presentation was an eye-opener and underscored the complexities and responsibilities that come with forecasting the weather.






