Guest Speaker: Sinclair Scholarship Recipient Holden Howell who received the Robert T. Leibold Scholarship. He is a paraplegic from an accident he had one year ago. He will share with us his first ever full upper body routine for wheelchair users, using non-accessible equipment in non-accessible gyms. After leaving physical rehab and coming home, he quickly realized that there are almost no public resources on how wheelchair users can weightlift. Over the last 11 months, Holden has built an almost fully independent routine, which wheelchair users worldwide should be able to use in almost any gym. I have a feeling that non-paraplegic individuals will benefit from his exercise routine also.

We are providing paid members (only \$100 annual membership fee) free use of our Zoom Account for meetings with no time limit. We are co-sponsors for the Bob Chiles Golf Outing, The Presidents Club of Dayton with Miami Valley Military Affairs Association since 1990 has donated over \$171,000 to the Fisher houses & over \$19,000 to First Sergeant's Association at WPAB. Next year's event is May 9^{th.}

Our Citizen Legion of Honor Award is one of the most Prestigious Volunteer Awards in our community. We announced the 5th Scholarship, The Anthony (Tony) Massoud Scholarship and donated to Sinclair College for the 5 Scholarships, each received \$2500. Our current endowment for the 5 Scholarships is self-sustaining to help maintain higher education for worthy students in our area who achieve high scholastics and volunteerism. The Presidents Club has raised over \$400,000 for Sinclair Scholarships because organizations like yours over the years with their \$100 membership fee, and fund-raising support have helped raise these monies.

We place your organization's name in our programs for the Outstanding Volunteer Award Ceremony and the Citizen Legion of Honor Award.


